# WELCOME TO THE 24TH ANNUAL \$100 FILM FESTIVAL

In 2012, Kodak discontinued their Ektachrome 100D colour reversal film on Super 8 and 16mm. This was the last remaining colour Super 8 film in production. Film enthusiasts mourned yet another small death for the medium, and scrambled to buy up what was left in circulation. 2016 marks the 50th anniversary of Super 8 film, and this year, analogue filmmakers anxiously await the resurrection of the medium by the newly re-opened Italian film company Film Ferrania. Ironically, Kodak has jumped on the analogue bandwagon, announcing an innovative new Super 8 camera as part of their celebratory Super 8 Revival Initiative.

As one of only a few exclusively small-format film festivals worldwide, we are thrilled to be part of this analogue renaissance. This year, we received over 100 submissions from around the world, and selected 35 films that challenge the boundaries of the medium and explore alternative approaches to storytelling. Meditations on space, place and identity are woven through each program with nods to documentary, narrative and traditional abstraction.

Many thanks to this year's programming jury: Natasha Jensen, Sanja Lukač & Bryce Maruk who have thoughtfully curated three nights of innovative small format films that celebrate the growing vitality of celluloid in the shadow of the digital age.
